Boating Safety

Anyone born after Jan 1st, 1988 must take a boating safety course in order to operate a boat of more than 10 horsepower. Check out the schedule for these courses at www. aboutboatingsafety.com. The course is named "About Boating Safety ".

Rules of Fueling: How it's done to avoid accidents

- If the boat has a closed cabin(s), close all hatches and ports before refueling.
- All guests and occupants should be off the boat and preferably away from the fuel dock.
- Turn all electrical accessories off.
- After fueling and before turning on the bilge blower, open the engine/ bilge compartment and sniff for fumes. If fumes exist, keep the compartment open and inspect for leaks or spills.
- No fumes? Now run the blower for 5 minutes.
- Then start the engines.
- Then invite your crew back onto the boat.

Stay safe, and share this checklist with your boating friends – you might just save them from having a really bad day!


