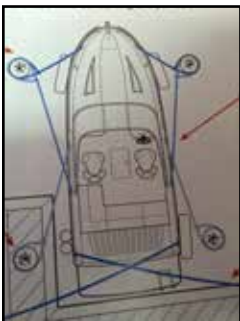

Tie It Up Right!



In case you were wondering, this is the preferred way to properly tie up a boat. The secret is to tie in the middle of the pole so the boat is the same

tightness at all tides. You don't want to "hang" at low tides or be pulled down by the high tides. You can also forget about the forward springlines, you only need the rears to keep you out from under the dock. Especially important w/ high tides lately!

Shuck and Share Oyster Recycling

This is an oyster recycling plan to enhance our shorelines. The oyster shells come from the local restaurants (Boondocks for one) and are "cured for 90 days. Then volunteers



either bag them up or build mats. The resulting product is "planted" along the shorelines to restore the normal and natural barrier. The shells stabilize the shoreline and the oyster larve settles in the shells and the process is started all over again.
