Father's Day ~ June 17

Flag Day ~ June 14th

Same day every year, commemorating the adoption of the flag of the United States, which happened on June 14, 1777.

Full "Strawberry" Moon ~

June 28. Named for the relatively short season of harvesting strawberries this month.

Summer Solstice ~ June 21

(The first day of summer and the longest day of the year)

9th Annual King of the Inlet Offshore Fishing Tournament

Leg #2 (Rescheduled): June 1-3

Leg #3: June 8-10

41st Annual NSB Striker Tournament

Teams to declare two fishing days between June 2 and June 22.

PREPARE YOUR BOAT FOR HURRICANES

YOUR BOAT IS **YOUR** RESPONSIBILITY. TAKE CARE BEFORE BAD WEATHER ARRIVES!

- Boats will have all compartments secured and all canvas wrapped or stowed.
- All batteries will be fully charged and tested prior to storm warnings.
- Verify all bilge pumps are operational on automatic and self bailing hulls are cleared from debris.
- Cover all electronic equipment.
- Check to ensure all fuel caps are snugged down tight.
- Remove all loose gear from the boat and dock. Stow it or bring it home.
- Remove all sails, especially roller furling jibs.
- All hatches should be dogged or secured.
- **In-water vessels** – Have dock lines doubled and secured to the dock poles at a height for all tidal swings with full chafe gear installed.
- **Lift vessels** – All boats on lifts should be lifted to the highest possible safe height. Secure boats to lift poles to keep boats from swinging. Follow instructions above to secure boat.


