Tricks of the Trade...

Anchor Upwind

Always anchor upwind of the group in a busy anchorage. If another boat drags, it'll drift away from you rather than towards you!



How Much Anchor Chain?

A trick to see how much anchor chain you've put out - mark the links with a neon paint spaced at 25-foot intervals. Paint one mark for the first 25 feet, two marks for the second and so forth. And put out enough to equal at least five times your water depth.

Change Zincs Often

Check zincs in your engine frequently.

A depleted zinc can result in significant damage to your engine, and costly repairs.

The same goes for shaft and other zincs



underwater outside the hull.

The Harbor Office has a steady supply of zincs.

Keep Bugs Off The Boat

Unwrapped spearmint gum on shelves will keep roaches and other bugs away from your food.



Look After Your Boat Head

If you're not going to use your head for a while, flush cooking oil down it to lubricate the works, and pour freshwater in to retard corrosion. Plastic wrap over the bowl will stop the ring from forming (Just don't forget to take it off before use!)

The World Is Your Oyster

One oysters can filter up to 50 gallons of water a day, essential to maintain a healthy coastal ecosystem. As for our health, oysters pack a whopping 16 grams of protein, tons of vitamins and only 10 calories each!

The locally owned **Indian River Oyster Company** (I.R.O.C.) combines a passion for

seaside living, conservation and the craft of farming oysters in the Mosquito Lagoon. They share their "craft" oysters with local

restaurants such as **Boondocks Restaurant**.

"We are excited to offer these excellent tasting oysters as a compliment to our wild-caught Gulf Oysters," said owner Sheryl Roach. **Boondocks** also participates in the **Marine Discovery Center's Shuck & Share Program** which has recycled over 400,000 lbs of oyster shells, returning them to the Indian River Lagoon Estuary as oyster beds and mats for the next generation of oysters!
